DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located on a hill, overlooking the intersection of Dorsey and Ridge Roads, is this large, two story frame house.

The structure consists of two parts, the South section is the larger. It has a three bay facade with inside, end chimneys. The entrance is in the center bay under a plain, one story porch. The front windows have large 2/2 pane sashes. The metalclad roof has a moderate pitch.

A long 2 story wing extends Eastward from the rear of the section just described. It has an open, 2 story porch on its South side.

Attached to the North side of the wing is another 3 bay, 2 story structure with a roof that is nearly flat. It too has a center door in the West elevation, flanked by two large 6/6 pane windows. The door is double, board and batten. An open shed roofed porch extends across the West elevation. The three second floor windows and all of the remaining windows in both parts of the house are relatively small, with 6/6 pane sashes. All of the windows have shutters. The exterior of the entire house is clad in white painted board siding.

The house was probably built in the mid 19th Century. The 1878 Hopkins map of Anne Arundel County shows that a house owned by John William Shipley stood in this location. The house was sold by John William Shipley in 1913 to the parents of the present owner. The smaller part of the building served as a store until 1913.(see attached sheets for more information).
