





They are set up on a base 3 steps high and have 6/6 windows, a simple wood box cornice, slightly sloping roofs, central chimneys, etc. Though in deteriorated shape, the scale of Pinkney Street should be maintained. (Buildings through No. 25 are a similar but slightly later row - same scale).</p>
