DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small, frame building, once used as a store, post office, and perhaps, earlier, as a school house, is located at the southwest corner of Mountain Road., at Old Mill Rd. It is rectangular in shape, one story high and three bays wide, under a high gable roof. The low foundation is iron stone. Weatherboards were put on over a layer of asbestos shingles in the 1970's when the building was converted to a real estate office. The main entrance is in the east gable end. Another entrance is sheltered by a small, partially enclosed shed roof porch at the third bay, rear elevation. A small chimney was removed from below the ridge of the north slope of the roof. A late 19th century Gothic Revival dwelling standing at the rear of the property has also been converted into office space.
