Box cornice; molded window caps at second floor and at paired windows at first, transom lit door; full width porch with square columns and elaborate sawn brackets.





Both have modern siding and very nicely embellished Victorian porches. Both have original sash (2/2), cornices, woodwork, etc. No. 5 has fine "Georg. revival" dormer and tin roof. No. 7 has a magnificent Victorian doorway - excellent example of type. Both houses adjoining fit scale of street - dormer, esp., matches dormer of No. 11. Houses obviously built at same time by same builder. No. 3 Cathedral - also same period - almost identical except without porch - closer to street and not nearly as interesting as 5 or 7</p>
