One unit of a pair of Four Square plan residences, 3 Murray Avenue is two stories, with a hipped roof and hipped dormers at front and side, both with paired l/l sash. Three by three bays, there is a full width one story porch on Doric columns with molded hand rail and square balusters. The overhanging roof has a stepped frieze and flat soffit. Windows and the transom lit entrance door have flat casings with molded lintel caps, with all sash l/l. There is a one story projecting bay unit at the first bay of the right end wall, and a two story semi-octagonal bay at the third bay, with the hipped roof swelling around the projection. The rectangular plan structure measures 20' x 60', including the original rear section and an infilled area that was a rear porch. There is a two car garage, of no architectural significance, at the rear of the property. Construction is frame , with clapboard.


