11 Murray Avenue is a two and one-half story, Four Square style frame residence with a hipped roof and hipped front dormer. Rectangular in plan, 33' x 48', three by three bays, the structure is sheathed with narrow clapboarding. All windows are 1/1, with those at the first floor cased with flat stock and lintel caps. The second floor windows are framed into the stepped frieze of the roof cornice. A full width one story, hipped roof porch has been partially infilled at the right one-third, with a paired 1/1 window lighting the space. The porch returns at the left end wall to run the full depth of the two and one-half story section of the house, and has Tuscan columns, molded hand rail and square balusters and a standing seam metal roof. Set back from the traditional frontage, 11 Murray Avenue has a one story tile garage at the rear of the property of no significance.


