A simple two story frame vernacular residence, 19 Murray Avenue is rectangular in plan, 20' x 50', three by three bays, with a gable roof and wood shingle siding. A full width one story porch with low hipped roof is supported on slender Tuscan columns, with a molded hand rail and square balusters. The porch is served by a long, straight run of wooden stairs. Windows are 1/1 with molded lintel caps, the cap repeated at the door in the left bay. A one story, two bay porch appended to the east part of the rear elevation is original to the house.





