A Four Square style, two and one-half story rectangular plan, 25' x 35', frame residence, 41 Murray Avenue has a hipped roof with hipped dormers at the front and side roofs, and a two story three part bay unit at the rear part of the east elevation. The deeply overhanging roof swells to protect the projecting bay, and has a stepped frieze. All windows are 6/1, including the paired sash in the dormers. All full width one story porch has a low hipped roof, tapered pilasters and solid wall area below the railing height. Three by three bays, the frame structure has a concrete block foundation and wood shingle walls. There is a one story concrete block garage, of no significance, at the rear of the property.






