Windows are 6/1, single at the four bay second level, arranged in a row of four to the right of the entrance, all with lintel caps. A corbeled capped chimney rises at the center of the three bay right side elevation and there is a two bay one story rear porch. The landscaped front yard is enclosed by an exceptional cast iron fence. There are five one car garages at the rear lot line, of no significance. The frame, rectangular structure, 4 by 3 bays, 25' x 35', has vinyl siding.
