A rare example of the Dutch Colonial Revival in the historic district this residence has a gambrel roof facing the street, with molded rakes that return above a full width porch. The porch has square posts and is infilled below the rail. Windows are 6/1, paired in the left bay of the second floor, and have flat casings with backbands and a lintel cap. The framing detail is repeated at the transom lit entrance door at the right bay. There are excellent pedimented dormers at the side elevations, and a full width rear porch. The frame with clapboard structure is rectangular in plan, 18' x 40'.
