The center section, which may date from the 18th century, has a gambrel roof with 2 shed dormers on each side. At either end of this section is attached a 2 story, 2 bay, A-roofed addition of much later date. The entire house has a wood shingle roof. The walls are covered in asphalt shingle.</p> <p>The house has been occupied by the Aisquith family since the late 1800's; Eliza Gray is listed as the owner on the 1878 county map.</p> <p>The old Drum Point Railroad ran along the western boundary of the farm and the road-bed is still visible. A pond, built so that the engines could replenish their water supply, is located nearby.</p>
