43 Southgate is a hipped roof vernacular residence. It has 4/4 sash flanking a side lit entrance at the first floor. A full width porch has a pedimented central bay, and like the main roof is standing seam. The left side elevation is four bays, all with 3/3 sash (the muntins set vertically) and a triple 3/3 window to the right of a hooded entrance, with paired 3/3 windows in the left part. A two bay rear ell has paired 3/3 sash in the right bay, triple 3/3s in the left. The frame structure, 22' x 35' in plan, is now sheathed with aluminum siding.


