A good example of the Four Square plan, 63 Southgate has a hipped roof with hipped dormer lit by a pair of casements, a full width front porch with hipped roof and fluted Scamottzi columns resting on stucco pedestals, and a two bay rear one story porch. The frame structure is now sheathed with asbestos shingles, and has a decoratively cast concrete block foundation. The 6/1 windows are paired at the second floor of the front facade, tripled at the firsts, single at the sides and rear elevations, with a small 6 light casement in the first bay of the right wall to light the interior stair. There is a corbeled chimney in the right elevation and a one story, one bay rear porch at the left corner of that elevation. Rectangular in plan, 24' x 40', two by two bays, two and one-half stories.




