A good example of the Dutch Colonial gambrel roof, two story residence, 67 Southgate has a full width wall dormer with two pairs of 6/1 windows, a molded cornice with returns and a pedimented entrance porch. The porch has a full entablature with Tuscan columns and returns at the cornice. The entrance has an excellent Georgian elliptical fan and sidelights and is in the extreme right bay, flanked by a large fixed sash of 18 lights. The first floor is brick on frame, the gable ends stucco. A one story porch spans the rear elevation, with screening and casement windows, and there is a raised terrace along the right end wall, with a side elevation. Rectangular in plan, 30' x 40' including the rear porch, there is a two car garage at the rear lot line.
