36 Southgate is a one and one-half story gambrel roof modified Dutch Colonial residence with an infilled front porch and three shed roof dormers, the center dormer smaller, with a 1/1 sash than the flanking ones, which have 6/1 sash. The cornice returns at the end elevations as a horizontal band, breaking at the right end wall to enclose a shallow, rectangular projecting bay that includes two paired casements. The remainder of this end wall has paired 6/1 sash in the rear bay and a massive, stepped brick chimney, a 6/1 window in the front bay and a small casement in the rear. The infilled porch has four pairs of hinged casements to the right of the new entrance. The stucco on frame structure is square in plan, 30' x 30', five bays at the front, two at the sides.






