A variety of the Four Square plan, 50 Southgate has a hipped roof with hipped dormers front and side, the front with paired 6/1 sash. Two and one-half stories high, three by two bays, the frame structure now has aluminum siding and a slate roof. Windows are paired at the second floor over the left bay entrance, single elsewhere. The entrance has six lite sidelights and a full width flat transom. A full width one story front porch with a low hipped roof is supported on square posts, with the wall surface below the rail sided with aluminum. A tall brick chimney pierces the right roof plane. A one bay, two story ell is appended to the rear at the right corner, probably original. Rectangular in plan, 30' x 40', there is a garage, of no significance at the left property line behind the residence.
