Windows are paired at the front elevation, first and second floor, single at the sides, all 6/1. The entrance in the right bay has no transom or sidelights. Rectangular in plan, 24' x 35', two by two bays, the stucco on tile structure has a one bay porch at the left half of the rear elevation and shares a two car garage that straddles the property line with 66 Southgate.


