A frame, two and one-half story residence with gable roof parallel to the street, 2 Taney Avenue has a large gable roof dormer with paired 6/1 sash, paired 6/1 sash in the right bay of the two bay front facade, a fan and side lit entrance in the right bay protected by a pedimented porch on slender Tuscan columns and a later three part projecting window unit in the left bay of the first floor. A full width, two story porch at the water (southeast) is open at the first floor, enclosed with glass jalousies at the second. The foundation is stucco on block, the walls aluminum siding, the roof covering asphalt. There is a one story rear porch at the north bay . There are no outbuildings.





