Two stories with a hipped roof, 8 Taney Street is a three by three bay stucco on tile vernacular residence with a pedimented door hood on square pilasters. The roof has an eyebrow window over the center bay and a deeply overhanging eaves with crown mold and frieze. Windows in the second floor are 6/6 while those at the outer bays of the first are grouped in threes, 4/4 sash flanking a 6/6. A one story with balustraded roof deck addition at the left end wall has three pivoting casements at the front, six at the side wall. Rectangular in plan, 45' x 25', the property is well landscaped with ground cover and specimen trees.
