This 20th century vernacular two story cottage has a gable roof with the ridge line parallel to the street and an extension of the gable at the left bay to protect an entrance inset behind the front elevation. The shed porch roof has a pedimented dormer and is supported on two Tuscan columns with a frieze and deep overhanging eave. The eave continues at the main block and returns, with molded rakes in the gable ends. There is also a two bay wide rectangular window extension at the right of the first floor, with four 4/1 windows. The windows in the dormer are 9 lite casements, all others are 6/1 double hung. Rectangular in plan, 35' x 45', there is a rear porch at the southeast corner.
