A double vernacular two story, four by three bay with a one bay rear section residence, 32-34 Madison Place has a gable roof with simple boxed cornice and two interior brick chimneys. Rectangular in plan, 15' x 32', plus the rear ell, windows are 2/2 with flat casings and molded lintels, the entrances in the end bays with flat transoms. A full width one story porch with hipped roof is supported on square posts with square balusters, and is reached by later brick stairs. Original clapboards on 34 Madison Place have been covered with asbestos shingles at 32. There are two one story storage sheds at the rear lot line, of no significance.



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
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
