11 Munroe Court is an excellent Bungalow, with cross gable roof extending over an open front porch. One and one-half stories high, five by four bays, it is rectangular in plan, 40' x 25', with a one story hipped roof rear porch. The front gable rests on square, shingled corner posts, with a shingled wall below the rail and concrete block stair with cheek walls. The attic level at all gables have six light casements, paired in the side elevations. All other windows are 6/1, paired at the left bay of the front facade and in a rectangular bay at the front part of the right elevation. The rakes of the gable ends are molded, with returns, with a flat frieze that breaks around the rectangular bay unit in the right wall. There is a corbeled capped brick chimney inset at the rear. The frame on concrete structure is shingled.




