A minor variety of the Bungalow style, 13 Munroe Court is a one and one-half story frame structure, rectangular in plan, 25'x 30' with a low hipped roof and hipped centered dormer with paired casements at the front elevation. A full width one bay deep porch is inset under the projecting roof, supported on tapered square posts that rest on brick piers that rise to rail height. The frame structure is sheathed with aluminum siding. The three bay front facade consists of a centered entrance flanked by paired 6/1 double hung windows, with all casings have molded back bands. The residence sits on a well landscaped lawn, with the street side enclosed with a period wrought iron fence.






