A one story hipped roof porch returns at the inset of the ell and is supported on Tuscan columns. Windows are 2/2 with flat casings and molded caps at all elevations. Two doors are set under the porch at the L. There is a one story, shed roof rear addition, c.1930s, at which time the present asbestos shingles were probably applied.






