One unit of a four part row of late 19th century vernacular structures, this residence has a gable roof with bracketed cornice, molded casings at the 6/6 windows and transom lit door, and a full width front porch that has had the turned wood posts replaced with wrought iron. The brick stoop is later, as is the asbestos siding. Rectangular in plan, 12' x 35', the structure is 2 x 2 bays with a slightly inset rear ell, probably original.






