This three bay by three, two story gable roof late 19th century vernacular structure has an exceptional pierced frieze at the bracketed cornice, flat window and transom door casings and is rectangular in plan, 18' x 45', with a two story rear ell, probably original. There is a garage at the rear lot line, of no significance. 87 Washington Street has been altered by the replacement of the full width porch at the front facade with a metal awning type roof supported on wrought iron posts. The cast concrete block platform and wrought iron rails are later. The original siding is obscured with asbestos shingles.





