9 Franklin Street is a two and one-half story cross gable residence of the Homestead variety, with pedimented gables at the front and rear sections of the side elevations. The rear gables extend over a semi-hexagonal breakfront bay. The cornice and rakes have a molded cornice and paneled frieze with returns at the front gable. Windows in all gables are paired, 6/1, those at the second floor single 1/1. The first floor of the front facade has a semi-octagonal bay with three 1/1 sash, and an entrance door. All windows and the door are cased with molded architraves and caps. A full width porch has a flat hip roof, and is supported on turned Tuscan columns, with a molded handrail square balusters. Rectangular in plan, 24' x 60', the frame on brick foundation structure is sheathed with vinyl siding, and has a full width one story, flat roof rear addition, c.1940.





