DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is marked on the 1860 and 1878 county maps as owned by George Franklin. It is of frame construction with one 2 story section and one 1 story section placed end to end. The house faces south. The larger section has a three bay front elevation with the entrance in the west end bay. The first floor windows are 6/6 pane openings. Those on the second floor are square with 3/3 pane sashes. The exterior is sheathed in horizontal wood siding. There is an exterior brick chimney at the east end. The interior plan of this section consists of one room with a narrow side hall and stair at the west end.

The smaller section also has an exterior brick chimney. The roof line of this section is asymmetrical. It has a long slope to the rear of the house, enclosing two tiny "cell" rooms. There is a small shed addition to the end of this section containing the kitchen.

The house is in poor condition. The chimney on the 1 story section is about to collapse. Most of the roof has been recovered. The north side of the roof of the smaller section still has wood shingle.

The hand-dug well, located Southeast of the house is still in use.
