While greatly altered, 1 Thompson Street is a minor variety of the Shingle Style, with a gambrel roof fronting on the street with shed dormers at the side elevations. The area at the peak of the gambrel has been altered by the inclusion of a contemporary, well designed attic window, and an original porch at the left has been infilled solid. The rakes of the gambrel return, the 6/1 sash are cased with flat trim and molded lintels, and the sidelit entrance at the right bay has a bracketed gable porch hood. The two story structure is rectangular in plan, 35' x 38', and is shingle on a high plastered basement, with an open storage area under the left infilled porch.






