Stucco on frame, 7 Thompson is a two story, gabled roof vernacular residence with the entrance located in the right side elevation, protected by a pedimented hood on square posts. Windows in the front facade, second floor are paired 6/1, with a triple window in the projecting bay unit at the right half of the first floor. The left part of the first floor of the front facade has paired hinged casements, protected by a shallow extension of a roof that returns over the one story addition at the side wall. Windows in the end walls are 6/1, paired in the rear bay of the right wall, which also has a stucco on brick tall chimney that pierces the wide overhanging roof eaves. The cornice is molded and returns at the end wall. Rectangular in plan, 30' x 28', the lot is well landscaped and there is a garage at the left rear.
