9 Thompson Street is a two and one-half stories, gable roofed stucco on frame 20th century vernacular residence with a large hipped dormer with paired sash, 6/1. All other sash is also 6/1, paired at the second floor front tripled at the first floor, to the left of the unlighted entrance. The house has a full width, one story hipped roof porch supported by square posts. A molded hand rail has square balusters, with the original stair rails replaced with wrought iron. Main roof retains its slate covering, and has a corbeled cap chimney at the right end. The structure has a one story rectangular projecting window at the rear bay of the left elevation, and a one story rear entrance porch at the left bay of that wall. The 2 by 2 bay plan measures 25' x 40', and there is a one story garage at the rear of no significance.






