A gable roof, stucco on frame three by two bay vernacular structure, 17 Thompson Street has a full width, hipped roof one story front porch with square posts, infilled with glass and three lit transom panels. The deep overhanging eaves of the gable ends have elaborate brackets terminating exposed purlins. Sash is 6/1, paired to the left of the entrance at the first floor, all with molded casings recessed behind the stucco, indicating that this finish may be later. The house is rectangular in plan, with the porch expanding the dimensions to 40' square.






