The exposed rafters at the side elevations are enclosed partially by a flat fascia with gutter. There is a good corbel capped chimney and an enclosed onebay wide, one bay deep entrance porch at the left bay of the front facade. Sash is 6/1, with a triple unit at the right of the entrance porch. Stucco on frame, there is a rear ell appended to the south bay of the rear elevation and a one story porch abutting this, occupying the center bay. There is also a one story garage, of no significance, at the rear lot line. Rectangular in plan, 25' x 28'.


