Two by two bays with a hipped roof with hipped dormer, the frame structure is covered with stucco, in all probability the original wall treatment. Windows at the second floor are 6/1 with flat casings, repeated at the first floor but paired in the right bay of the front facade and the left bay of the right end wall. A full width porch with hipped roof is supported on battered stucco-faced columns, with the fascia between segmental arches. The first floor front facade has a transom lit entrance and a single 6/1 window to the right of the door in addition to the paired sash at the corner.




