This three unit row vernacular structure is two stories high, with a shallow gable roof and projecting bracketed cornice with paneled frieze. Each of the three gable units is two bays wide, with a total frontage of 40' x 25 deep. A full width porch is supported by turned columns with a molded hand rail and square balusters. All windows are 2/2, set in flat casings with molded lintel caps. The three entrance doors have flat transoms and similar trim. The frame structure rests on a concrete block foundation, with block piers at the porch. The walls are sheathed with asbestos shingles, the roof is standing seam metal.
