DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

"Hall's Grove" is a 5-bay, 2 1/2 story brick house dating from about 1840. It has a frame kitchen addition, ca. 1920, on its west gable end. There are ~~also~~ several barns and a windmill near the house, all dating from the 20 century.

The main house has a center entrance on the north and south facades. The north, or front, entrance is covered by a columned, A-roof porch. There are three gabled dormers on each side of the roof and two slender chimneys at each end. The house stands on a raised basement without a water table. The windows are all 6/6 with flat, brick lintels and stone sills. The shutters have been removed.

The interior of the house is simple, with plain moldings and mantels. Both the interior and exterior have been repaired in recent years and the house is now in good condition. The brick used here is unusually soft and was beginning to crumble, so much of it was replaced by the present owner. The house stands on a knoll, surrounded by open fields. The three large hemlocks and the two box-wood **in front** of the house are the most prominent plantings.
