109 Clay Street is a two and one-half story, hipped roof Four Square style residence, rectangular in plan (20' x 30') three by two bays at the first floor. The roof has a wide hipped dormer with paired two light casements and deeply overhanging eaves. All windows are 1/1 with molded caps, the door has 15 glass lights. Asbestos shingles presently hide the original sheathing, probably clapboard. A full width, one-story porch across the north (front) facade has later wrought iron pilasters and later wrought iron rail and balusters. The foundation and porch piers are of rough cast concrete. Eight wood stairs serve the porch.
