Two by two bays in design, the windows have 6/1 sash and molded caps, the door is a square glass panel over raised horizontal panels. The standing seam metal roof has deeply overhanging eaves with a flat frieze. A full width one-story porch is supported on turned Tuscan columns, with molded hand rail and square balusters except for the rails at the concrete stairs, which are pipe railings. The foundation and porch piers are cast concrete, with the lower section of the porch infilled at a later date with cast concrete block.




