The area above the porch has been infilled at a later date with a shed roof dormer with paired 6/1 sash. The entrance bay has a gabled window in the second floor and a centered entrance with full entablature. The two bay wide porch has been infilled, and the entire structure sheathed with aluminum siding. A one bay rear entrance porch is located at the southwest corner. The structure is two stories, three by three bays and has an exterior brick chimney in the east end wall.




