The roof has a simple boxed cornice at all four sides. The full width porch has been infilled c.1940. Second floor windows at the front facade are paired, all windows 1/1 in molded casings. A one story, one bay rear porch is located at the northwest corner. Asbestos shingles applied over original siding, probably clapboard.




