Heavy overhanging cornice with flattened consoles and brackets, deep fascia; cut brownstone pilaster strips dividing each third of structure from its neighbors; Second and third floor windows arranged as ribbons of three 1/1's, with wood spandrels; first floor as shop front probably original.





