A gable to the street front porch extends the full width of the front facade, with heavy tapered posts and screen infill. Windows are 1/1, paired at the second floor of the front 3 bay facade, single at the 4 bay sides, all with flat casings. A one story shed roof bay unit is appended to the center two bay area of the right side elevation, with exposed rafter ends—the main roof cornice and rakes are boxed. Rectangular in plan, 20'x30', with no outbuildings.

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
