Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)

St. Anne's Church is listed in the National Landmark Historic District of Annapolis as a contributing resource. Additionally a Maryland Historic Sites Inventory form was completed in the early 1990s. The previous documentation did not address the nearby, but related cemetery. While St. Anne's Cemetery in and of itself is not located within the boundary of the Annapolis Historic District, nor is the cemetery considered individually eligible for the National Register of Historic Places, it is part of, and intensifies the significance of the Church. The purpose of this DOE is to append information regarding the St. Anne's Church and establish the two discontinuous properties (199 Duke of Gloucester and 100 Northwest) as one site considered eligible for the National Register.

The Church itself was officially established in 1692. Construction began on the building in circa 1696. The present day building was constructed immediately after a furnace fire in 1858 in the Romanesque Revival style. The interior features of the Church include the stone Altar and Font that were carved by the Maryland sculptor, William Henry, and a stained glass window by Tiffany Studios.

St. Anne's Cemetery is just southwest of Rowe Road and west of the Annapolis Historic District. Historically, cemeteries of the 18th century were laid out at the outskirts of town, so the location away from the actual building is not unusual. Architecturally, the cemetery offers a mixture of cemetery art, from the Colonial period, (oldest stone has date of 1767) tablet style markers, to the more elaborate Victorian era pedestals, obelisks, and cherubs. The overall landscaping of the cemetery is rolling and leading downward toward College Creek.

According to William K. Paynter's publication, "St. Anne's Annapolis History and Times," there are some notable Annapolitans buried in Saint Anne's Cemetery. These include members of the Chancellor Johnson, Commodore Mayo, Randall, Buchanan, Mackubin, Murray, Key, Pickney, Claude, Fell, Tilton, Waddell, Dorsey, and Brice families.

Therefore, it is considered that St. Anne's Church and Cemetery are considered eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.






