<p>This is a 2-story frame farm house on a raised brick basement. It was built shortly after the Civil War by Thomas S. Talbott whose name appears on the 1878 map of the county. The house is on an ell-shaped plan with an A-roof. The pitch is very slight in comparison to that of pre-war houses. The front section has three bays with a side entrance. There is one large chimney on the north end. The kitchen is in the rear wing.</p> <p>The exterior of the house was altered somewhat in the 1940's: asbestos shingle was put over the original wood siding, a porch was added to the front and a rectangular bay built on the south side.</p> <p>The property is now a large working farm.</p>
