Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)
This is a one-story frame residence, located on the north side of ancestral Old Quarterfield Road. The house is situated on slight rise, and there are a few shrubs as well as more mature trees around the property. Asbestos shingles and vinyl siding cover the house, and asphalt shingles protect the roof. The gable roof is oriented to the side of the road, and there are two small, projecting gables on the south wall and the west walls of this small building. The projecting gables serve as enclosed, glazed entrances or vestibules for the house. An in-ground, double-leaf cellar door and an exterior, concrete block chimney are located at the west gable end of the house. There is a single-cell addition on the west end of the house, constructed of particleboard. The house appears date from ca. 1945-1955, and it has picture windows as well as one-over-one sash windows. There are several small trailers and a small frame shed in the rear yard to the north.

This is a simply styled, small house dating from the post World War II period. The property lacks significant architectural distinction and therefore would not meet the National Register Criterion C. Furthermore, the Cosby House has no known significant association with important persons or events, nor would it likely have significance for the potential information contained in associated archaeological materials (Gibb, March 2001). The Cosby House would not qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria A, B, C, or D.


