DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

It is believed that "Hawthorne Ridge" was built in 1839 by Dr. James Cheston of Philadelphia. A baseboard in the living room was signed and dated by the carpenter (named White).

The home is now the center of a large horse farm. It was bought in 1939 by the present owner. Major renovations were then undertaken. A new, 2 story, kitchen, almost identical in exterior detail to the old, was built in the same location on the north side of the house. A porch was replaced on the east side of the house, and some changes were made to the interior.

The roof ridge of the main house runs east to west. The front and garden entrances are on the gable ends of the building, producing an unusual orientation and floor plan for the period and the region. The window details, emphasis on the gable ends, and the small pedimented entrance porch on the west side are adaptations of the "Greek Revival" style which is seldom seen in the area.

The dining-room and living-room are on the east side and each has a jib-door opening onto the porch. The two rooms are divided by ceiling height doors. The mantels, and the wainscoting in the hall are new. Cornice, baseboards and flooring are original.

The house is now in excellent condition.
