

DESCRIPTION


Building NA119, an Antenna Cable Storage Building, overlooks Chesapeake Bay on the east side of East Road north of its intersection with Cross Point Road in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. Naval Academy North Severn records indicate erection of the structure occurred in 1944.

The storage building stands one-story tall in an elongated rectangular plan with a corrugated-tin gable roof (Photo 41634-4). Corrugated tin also sheathes the exterior walls. The building's framing consists of wooden trusses atop poles set onto a poured concrete foundation. A pair of double-paned awning windows penetrate the east gable end while corrugated-tin double leaf doors set above a poured-concrete loading dock occupy the west gable end. The north and south elevations display single awning windows. The south elevation also possesses a door opening but lacks doors (Photo 41634-5).
