Located within the Tipton Airfield, Fort Meade, Building T-92 is a WWII temporary frame building which was originally located in the range area of the base. The one-story, single pile building measures six bays wide is supported by concrete piers. The gable roof is sheathed in asphalt shingles and is interrupted by a single metal chimney. The modest building is typical of its military vintage and displays no defining ornamentation. Based on its features, Fort Meade believes T-92 was used as a day room (recreation) building. Moved to its present location in the 1980s, the building does not meet the NR criteria or consideration B.


