Galesville evolved as a water-related village from the 17th through the mid-19th centuries. The surviving historic standing structures range in period from the third quarter of the 19th century until the present. The historic structures are predominately of wood construction and include simple I-houses, cross-gables, bungalows, modest Queen-Anne style variants, and a few small gable-front stores. There are a large number of non-contributing resources mixed in.

Although Galesville maintains the scale of a small waterfront community, it lacks the cohesive historic architectural character which conveys a sense of time and place. The widespread mix of modern structures with historic buildings does not provide the concentration of continuity of features which typically characterize an historic district. Even though Galesville is an historic village, the standing structures do not effectively convey the sense of an historic district. Some of the historic buildings may be eligible for the National Register individually, but the village does not achieve significance as a whole within its historic context.
