DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

At the top of a high, wooded bluff overlooking the Rhode River stand the ruins of Ivy Neck. The house was built in 1787 by James Cheston, a Baltimore merchant and a son-in-law of Samuel Galloway of Tulip Hill. Cheston's descendants in the Morris, Murray, and Colhoun families occupied the house until it was destroyed by fire in 1944.

Chestons' house was a federal style, three-story, brick structure, with a center hall and a five-bay front. In 1858, Dr. Caspar Morris, husband of Cheston's grand-daughter, added a brick wing containing a library and a metal clad frame tower. One chimney is all that remains today.

Ivy Neck Farm retained its 18th century boundaries until the 1960's when parts of it were divided among Cheston descendants and the remainder was acquired by the Smithsonian Institution - Chesapeake Bay Center for Environmental Studies.

An important collection of 18th and 19th century family papers has been preserved through the care and abiding interest of Cheston descendants. Much of that material is on loan to the Maryland Historical Society, where it may be viewed only with permission of the owner; John M. Colhoun, Ivy Neck Farm.
